Our Typical Day

Students can take part in a many clubs/activities/sports.

CYO: (Catholic Youth Organization) offers a variety of sports. Most teams start in 5th grade, but some are for younger students (Cross Country; Flag Football; Track; Field Hockey). *Associated fees.*

Band: We use Northeastern Music Program. Third graders can play violin only; 4-8 grades can choose from a variety of instruments. *Associated fees; if needed, instruments are sold/rented separately.*

Young Rembrandts/Science Explorers: Grades 1-6. *Associated fees.*

Service Club: once a month meetings to make cards and baskets for local residents who are sick or less fortunate.

School Newspaper/Yearbook Club: students meet during lunch twice a month to publish the newspaper or discuss content for the Yearbook.
